


Alliance for Innovation on Maternal Health (AIM)

Life Course Model














HRSA Maternal Mortality Summit (June 2018)

- Title V is the oldest Federal/State partnership
- Title V provides partial or complete funding support for maternal mortality activities, which may include maternal mortality review committees (MMRC), in 56 of 59 States/jurisdictions


- Title V-supported activities:
