



Linda M. Kaste, D.D.S., Ph.D., M.S.

Linda M. Kaste attended college at Albright College in Reading, PA and dental school at the University of Maryland in Baltimore, MD. She obtained a Master of Science Degree and a certificate in Dental Public Health at Harvard University and a Ph.D. in Epidemiology at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. Her dissertation was on reproductive health outcomes as related to several occupational exposures for female dentists. She is a Diplomate of the American Board of Dental Public Health, being the only female who is a boarded specialist in Dental Public Health in Illinois. An overarching theme of her dental career has been to improve the oral health status of populations with limited access to care, particularly concerning early childhood caries. She has 20 peer-reviewed manuscripts and over 76 presentations or meeting abstracts. In October 2004 she received the Racial Justice Award from the YWCA of Metropolitan Chicago. She is Associate Professor and Director of Predoctoral Dental Public Health at the University of Illinois at Chicago College of Dentistry and Adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago School of Public Health.
