Dr. Rebecca DelCarmen-Wiggins co-leads two flagship programs of the NIH Office of Research on Women's Health (ORWH): (1) the Specialized Centers of Research Excellence (SCORE) on Sex Differences program, which promotes innovative translational research focusing on sex differences and major medical conditions affecting women, and (2) the Intersection of Sex and Gender Influences on Health and Disease research award program, ORWH's and NIH's first investigator-initiated, disease-agnostic R01 on sex and gender support research on the influence and intersection of sex and gender in health and disease. She also is on the core Sex as a Biological Variable (SABV) team for ORWH.



Before joining ORWH, Dr. DelCarmen-Wiggins was a Health Scientist Administrator at the National Institute of Mental Health, overseeing a portfolio in developmental translational research, and she was the recipient of an F32 postdoctoral research award with the *Eunice Kennedy Shriver* National Institute of Child Health and Human Development. She is a licensed psychologist in Maryland and Washington, DC, with prior teaching experience at American University and Georgetown University.
