Maggi A. Price (she/her) is an assistant professor in the School of Social Work at Boston College and director of the Affirm Lab. She also serves as a psychology associate in the Department of Psychology at Harvard University, where she completed her postdoctoral research fellowship in child psychotherapy effectiveness and



implementation at the Laboratory for Youth Mental Health.

Dr. Price earned her Ph.D. in counseling psychology from Boston College in 2018, her M.A. in counseling psychology from the University of Hawaii Hilo in 2012, and her B.S. in psychology and sociology from the University of Oregon in 2010. She completed her clinical training at Yale University School of Medicine after finishing clinical practica as a Harvard Medical School fellow at Cambridge Health Alliance and Massachusetts General Hospital. Across these settings, she trained in culturally responsive, evidence-based practice for children, adolescents, and adults with a focus on trauma-related psychopathology.

Dr. Price's research focuses on the intersection between stigma, trauma, and youth mental health, with an emphasis on understanding and effectively addressing the experiences of transgender and non-binary young people.
