Dr. Rajeev K. Agarwal is a Senior Research Program Officer in the NIH Office of Research on Women's Health (ORWH). He co-leads two of ORWH's flagship programs: (1) the Specialized Centers of Research Excellence (SCORE) on Sex Differences, which promotes innovative translational research focusing on sex differences and major medical conditions affecting women, and (2) the administrative supplement program to support research highlighting the impact of sex (as a biological variable) and gender (as a social construct) influences on human health and illness. He is also the Senior Scientific Lead/Coordinator for all COVID-19-related activities at ORWH and is Co-Chair of the COVID-19 Working Group of the Coordinating Committee on Research on Women's Health (CCRWH).



Dr. Agarwal holds M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Lucknow in India. He performed his research at one of India's premier institutes, the Central Drug Research Institute (CDRI) in Lucknow.
