Dr. Gyamfi-Bannerman is a board-certified maternal–fetal medicine specialist who is internationally recognized for her work in obstetric complications, with a primary focus on preterm birth, both in prevention and in the use of antenatal corticosteroids. In her leadership roles with the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and the Society for Maternal-Fetal Medicine, she has co-authored numerous clinical guidelines for obstetric practice.



Dr. Gyamfi-Bannerman has conducted multiple NIH-funded clinical trials and has published numerous research papers in peer-reviewed scientific journals, including *JAMA* and *The New England Journal of Medicine*. She was recognized twice by the *American Journal of Obstetrics & Gynecology* for research excellence, received the Society for Maternal-Fetal Medicine Research Award, and was elected to the American Gynecological & Obstetrical Society. She earned her bachelor's degree at the University of Miami and her medical degree at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. She completed her residency in obstetrics and gynecology at the University of Miami and Jackson Memorial Hospital and her fellowship at Mount Sinai Hospital.
