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Dr. Kunos is a radiation oncologist who currently oversees clinical cancer trials, oversees CRO processes and activities, and leads MCC's efforts to decrease time to activation across all types of trials, in preparation for the renewal of its National Cancer Institute designation in September 2022. Additionally, Dr. Kunos is a member of MCC's Translational Oncology Research Program and is a Professor of Radiation Medicine in the University of Kentucky College of Medicine.

Dr. Kunos received his medical degree and Ph.D. from Case Western Reserve University. He previously served as a Medical Officer in the Investigational Drug Branch at the National Cancer Institute's Cancer Therapy Evaluation Program. In that role, he encouraged experimental therapeutic discovery, implemented clinical trials, monitored clinical trial toxicities, reported adverse events to regulatory agencies, and provided public stewardship of U.S. government resources.
